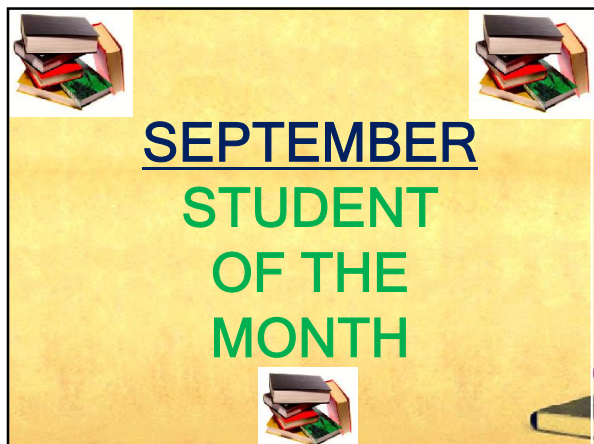


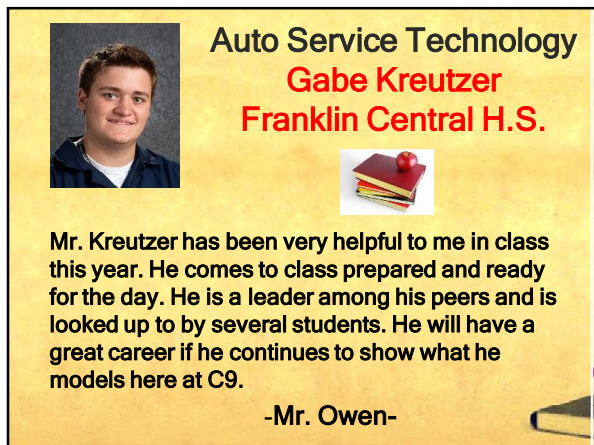
# Students of the Month September 2016

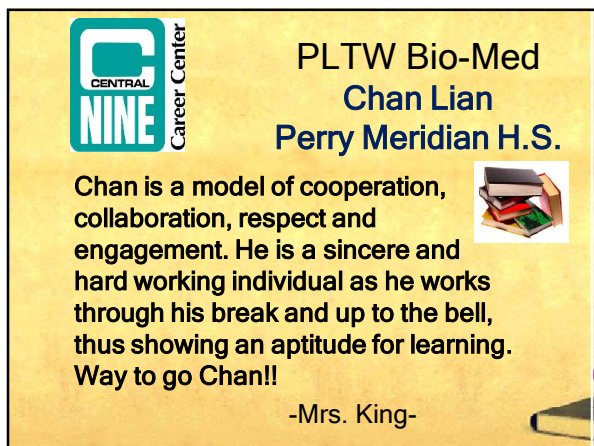


## Aviation Hannah Reid Whiteland Community
