On Thursday, March 19, 2020, Governor Holcomb announced that all public schools will be closed until May 1, 2020. This decision does include the Central Nine campus.

Central Nine leaders have created an eLearning schedule that will allow instructors and students to collaborate steadily while still utilizing our waiver days.

**Our eLearning schedule will proceed as follows:** Every **Monday, Wednesday, and Friday** starting April 13th will be eLearning days.

Week 1: April 13th, 15th, and 17th

Week 2: April 20th, 22nd, and 24th

Week 3: April 25th, 29th, and May 1st

*(April 6th - 10th will be professional development days for our instructors. These days are for instructors to prepare curriculum, answer questions, and collaborate with other staff members.)*
