On Thursday, April 3, 2020, Governor Holcomb announced that all school campuses will be closed for the remainder of the spring 2020 semester. This decision does include the Central Nine campus.

Central Nine leaders have updated an eLearning schedule that will allow instructors and students to collaborate steadily while still utilizing waiver days.

Our eLearning schedule will proceed as follows: Every **Monday, Wednesday, and Friday** starting April 13th will be eLearning days.

Week 1: April 13th, 15th, and 17th

Week 2: April 20th, 22nd, and 24th

Week 3: April 25th, 29th, and May 1st

Week 4: May 4th, 6th, and 8th

Week 5: May 11th, 13th, and 15th



May 15, 2020 will be our last day of eLearning and the last day of the 2019-2020 school year. May 18 - 21 are not official school days, however, Central Nine staff and instructors will still be available online for students to contact if needed.

Students should continue to communicate with their instructors for questions regarding course work.
