On **Monday, March 1, 2021, Central Nine will return to 100% in-person learning on a daily basis.** The hybrid schedule we have observed since November will effectively end on Friday, February 26th, at the end of the school day. With all students attending on a daily basis, Central Nine will continue to work with the Johnson County Health Department and adjust the schedule as needed throughout the rest of the school year.

Reminder:

- Check Temperatures Daily. Students must be fever-free for 24 hours, before returning to campus.
- Masks must be worn at all times when social distancing cannot be maintained AND cover the mouth and nose simultaneously.
